


5. OPERATION CONTROLS AND FUNCTIONS

5.1 Top Panel



1 Input LED 1~4: The blue LED will illuminate to indicate the selected source.

5.2 Left Panel




Optical In: Connect to the source equipment such as DVD/Blu-ray players, set-top boxes or game consoles for audio input signal routing.






5.3 Right Panel



- 1 Power: Press to turn on the device or to set it to standby mode. The blue LED on the top panel will illuminate when the device is powered and switched on.
- 2 Input: Select the input port from 1 to 4. The blue LED on the top panel will illuminate to indicate the selected source.
- 3 Optical Out: Connect to an amplifier or active speaker with optical cable for audio output.
- 4 IR: IR receiver window that receives the IR signal from the supplied remote control. Please ensure that there is a clear line-of-sight between the receiver and the remote.


5.4 Rear Panel



1 DC 5V: Connect the 5V DC power supply into the unit and plug the adaptor to an AC wall outlet.

5.5 Remote Control


- **POWER:** Press to turn on the devic; press it again to put the device into standby mode.
